Much of the course's emphasis is on case studies.

Each Group must present their assignment at least once during semester and prepare Group Presentation material for class discussion. Marking Scheme of the Group will be:

- 2. Delivery of the presentation: 40 %

Each Group have to submit 1 paper about the 2 chosen Companies, content of the paper must at least have :

1. Accounting and Financial Performance Analysis of each Company.

Each Group have to submit 1 paper about the 2 chosen Companies, content of the paper must at least have :

- 1. 5 years financial projections based on valid assumptions
- 2. Equity valuation
- 3. Give recommendation buy / sell / hold based on the analysis
- 4. Credit Analysis
